

SPEAKER CODE OF CONDUCT

As an invited speaker of WAMM, please review the following code of conduct for speakers.

A speaker is defined as any sanctioned individual who is presenting material to a conference audience. That material includes lectures, posters, discussion groups and workshops.

Please initial and date the bottom of the page where indicated to demonstrate that you have received, reviewed and will comply with the following:

- a) Disclosure Slide: indicating any relevant financial relationships.
- b) Patient permission: if patient images are shown the individual faculty must have appropriate permission to do so.
- c) WAMM expects considerate and educationally sound discourse from all of its speakers.
- d) Verbal discussion, written or pictorial material **MUST** be devoid of any reference to the following:
 - a. Violence.
 - b. Sexual discrimination.
 - c. Discrimination based on gender, religion, race, sexual orientation or nationality.

Failure to abide by the speaker code of conduct will result in review by the organising committee which may include input from the session moderator and co-panelists at the discretion of the organising committee. Following review appropriate sanctions will be instituted.

If you feel that you cannot comply with this code of conduct, please inform the conference organiser immediately.

If you have any questions regarding this code of conduct, please contact the conference organiser for clarification at your earliest convenience.
